Resolution: The District & Sessions Judge, Sivasagar, at the outset, has referred to a Case no. 06 (S-N)/2020 which is pending for statement of I.O. In this regard, the Hon'ble District & Sessions Judge, Sivasagar has requested the Superintendent of Police, Sivasagar present in the meeting to do the needful so that the aforementioned case can be disposed off at an early date possible.

The Superintendent of Police, Sivasagar, referring to the previous issue relating to delay in the service of summons, has informed the members present in the meeting that necessary orders have already been issued in this regard to the concerned so that the summons are served on time facilitating swift disposal of cases.


The Superintendent of Police, Sivasagar has brought the notice of the members to the issue of non-availability of the details regarding the I.O.'s, Case nos. etc. in the copy of the daily Court orders served in the name of the Supdt. of Police. In this regard, the Superintendent of Police, Sivasagar has informed the Hon'ble District & Sessions Judge, Sivasagar that, if the details are provided, then it would be helpful for them in carrying out the necessary instructions of the Court swiftly.

The Superintendent of Police, Sivasagar has informed the Hon'ble District & Sessions Judge, Sivasagar that steps for recording statements made under section 161 CR.P.C by audio-visual means have been initiated from their part to facilitate memory refreshing prior to recording of evidence in the Hon'ble Court, and thereby contributing towards an increasing conviction rate.


The Superintendent of Police, Sivasagar has also informed that in NDPS Cases, necessary steps are being taken for the presence of seizure witness during search and seizure as per relevant sections of the NDPS Act.
