AGENDA

Item : To discuss the matter relating to the strengthening of monitoring mechanism for expeditious investigation and trial of cases.

Resolution: The Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sivasagar placed before the members of the committee regarding the matter related to Sivasagar PS Case No. 437/18, which is pending before the Court of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sivasagar for receipt of charge sheet. The Superintendent of Police, Sivasagar apprised the members of the committee that the necessary step for placing the same before the concerned Court shall be taken at an earliest date possible. The Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sivasagar also requested the Superintendent of Police, Sivasagar to take step for sensitizing the I.Os regarding the related issues.

The members of the Committee unanimously requested the Superintendent of Police, Sivasagar to ensure that the permanent address of the accused and the witnesses for a particular case be attached along with the Case Diary, so that the communication may be made in proper course of time. It has also been requested to direct the I.O.'s to put stress on the importance of statements made under 161 Cr.P.C.

The members of the Committee have also made a threadbare discussion regarding the determination of proper age of the accused taking plea of juvenility, and the members unanimously requested the Superintendent of Police, Sivasagar to direct the I.O's to be more careful when such plea has been taken.

The Superintendent of Police, Sivasagar apprised the members of the Committee that 46 (forty six) nos. of cases are pending in various police stations due to the death of I.O's. The District & Sessions Judge, Sivasagar put forward suggestions to the Superintendent of Police, Sivasagar that based on the application made before the concerned Courts reconstruction of case(s) may be considered for the particular cases.


The members of the Committee have also made discussion on the various aspects related to POCSO Cases and requested the Superintendent of Police, Sivasagar to direct I.O's to be careful while handling these cases, so that all the legal provisions are strictly being followed and also direct the I.O's to seek consultation of the Public Prosecutors thoroughly.

The meeting ends with vote of thanks from the chair.
