Item : To discuss the matter relating to the strengthening of monitoring mechanism for expeditious investigation and trial of cases.

Resolution: At the outset, the District and Sessions Judge, Sivasagar has welcomed all the members of the committee. Initiating the discussion, the District and Sessions Judge, Sivasagar has asked the SP, Sivasagar, present in the meeting, to take necessary steps for ensuring the presence of the witnesses who were staying at rented accommodation and are not found in the same address at present. He has also informed the SP, Sivasagar that a list of such cases along with the names of the witnesses shall be furnished to him for doing the needful from his end.

The Additional District and Sessions Judge, FTC, Sivasagar present in the meeting, has referred to a Sessions case no. 04 (S-S)/21 where the summons was not received by the witness willingly. The Additional District and Sessions Judge, FTC, Sivasagar has requested the SP, Sivasagar to direct the concerned I.O. to definitely ensure the presence of the witness as per the provision of the Cr.P.C.

During the discussions, the SP, Sivasagar has requested the Public Prosecutor present in the meeting to continue the exercise of furnishing the list of cases on monthly basis which are pending for I.O.s in various Courts, so as to reap the benefits of this exercise in near future as well.

During the meeting, discussions were also made regarding the taking up of MV Act cases in regular Courts on some days of a week. The CJM, Sivasagar has informed the members of the committee that the matter has already been taken up and the learned Courts have been requested to take up the MV Act Cases pending in their respective Courts at least 2 (two) days in a week.


The PP, Sivasagar, present in the meeting has requested the SP, Sivasagar to direct the concerned I.O.s to compulsorily furnish report



clearly stating the reasons for non-production of the C.D.s before the learned Courts on time in such instances.


Concluding the discussions, the District and Sessions Judge, Sivasagar has referred to Sessions Case No. 183(S-S)/22 wherein the summons ^{issued to} the victim and the informant have returned unserved, and has asked the SP, Sivasagar to direct the concerned I.O. to ensure the presence of both the victim and the informant along with the concerned I.O. on the next date fixed by the learned Court.
