**Item** : To discuss the matter relating to the strengthening of monitoring mechanism for expeditious investigation and trial of cases.

**Resolution:** The Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sivasagar has placed before the members of the committee regarding the improper service of summons in different cases including incidents of non-execution of NBW's and non-receipt of warrants after issuance. The Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sivasagar requested the Superintendent of Police to direct the concerned IO's to be more precise and careful while servicing of summons.


The member of the Committee has made a discussion regarding PRC Case No.745/19 in which the I.O. has stated as accused not found in the proclamation. The Superintendent of Police, Sivasagar has been asked to direct the concerned I.O.s to serve the processes as per the requirement of the Courts. The District & Sessions Judge, Sivasagar has asked the Superintendent of Police, Sivasagar to ensure that the C.D.s be updated when the accused is presented before the Court.


The Superintendent of Police, Sivasagar has sought suggestions to remove the discrepancy in the data regarding the no. of disposed cases collected from the respective Courts and the data that is submitted by the I.O's and in some cases the concerned I.O's have expired. The Chief Judicial Magistrate put forward his suggestion that reconstruction of the concerned cases may be done if the concerned authority submit a prayer before the Court for the same.

The District & Sessions Judge, Sivasagar in the discussion has also referred to a Sessions Case no. 196/2022 in which the statement under 161 Cr.P.C has not been found. The District and Sessions Judge, Sivasagar has asked the Superintendent of Police to direct the concerned I.O's to be more careful in this regard.

In the meeting the Superintendent of Police, Sivasagar has made a reference to Case no. 1001/2014 in which post-mortem report has not been received yet, from the medical authorities, and has sought suggestions regarding the same. The Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sivasagar has advised the Superintendent of Police, Sivasagar to issue an official letter seeking medical report from AMCH, Dibrugarh.
