Item : To discuss the matter relating to the strengthening of monitoring mechanism for expeditious investigation and trial of cases.

Resolution: The District & Sessions Judge, Sivasagar, at the outset, has made an observation that in many cases the witnesses have informed the Court that they were asked their name and address only at the time of investigation and no such versions as presented before the Court by the I.O.'s have been made by them and thus, the versions bear no truthfulness as they have not been asked by the concerned I.O.'s. In this regard, the District & Sessions Judge, Sivasagar has asked the Addl. S.P. (Crime) present in the meeting to direct the concerned I.O.'s to be more careful while presenting any case before the Court.


The District & Sessions Judge, Sivasagar has also made an observation that in the 'Briefing Section' attached alongwith the charge sheets, very fewer details are being provided by I.O.'s. He has asked the Addl. S.P. (Crime) present in the meeting to direct the concerned I.O.'s to write the briefing in an elaborate manner so as to enable the Court to deal with the concerned cases in a proper manner.

The Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sivasagar has drawn the attention to the issue wherein in many cross cases, especially in land related matters, the name of the aggressor is not often clearly mentioned. In this regard, the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sivasagar has asked the Addl. S.P. (Crime) present in the meeting to direct the concerned I.O.'s to be more precise and clear in this regard.


The District & Sessions Judge, Sivasagar has also made an observation regarding non-submission of Case Diaries by the I.O.'s on time which creates inconvenience to the Court proceedings. In this regard, the District & Sessions Judge, Sivasagar has asked the Addl. S.P. (Crime) present in the meeting to direct the concerned I.O.'s to look into the matter and be more prompt in this regard.

The Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sivasagar has also asked the Addl. S.P. (Crime) present in the meeting to look into the matter of advance intimation to the Court(s) regarding the transfer of the I.O.'s. and it has been felt by the members present in the meeting that, this will help in saving considerable amount of precious Court time.

The District & Sessions Judge, Sivasagar has asked the Addl. S.P. (Crime) present in the meeting to ensure that the permanent address, contact nos., e-mail ID (if any), registered WhatsApp nos. (if any) of the accused and the witnesses for a particular case be attached along with the case diary, so that the communication may be made in proper course of time.
