**AGENDA**

**Item** : To discuss the matter relating to the strengthening of monitoring mechanism for expeditious investigation and trial of cases.

**Resolution:** The District & Sessions Judge, Sivasagar, at the outset, has made an observation that in most of the charge sheets filed, it is mentioned that the cause of death may be ascertained after FSL Report. Therefore, the District & Sessions Judge, Sivasagar has asked the representative of the Police authority present in the meeting to direct the concerned I.O.s to ascertain the cause of death while filing the charge sheets.

The District & Sessions Judge, Sivasagar has asked the representative of the Police authority present in the meeting to direct the concerned I.O.s to properly implement the provisions as provided under Sec. 42 of the NDPS Act in cases pertaining to the Act. The District & Sessions Judge, Sivasagar has also emphasised on timely production of Charge sheets by the concerned I.O.s to minimize the grant of default bails due to non production of Charge sheets within the stipulated period particularly in NDPS cases.

The Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sivasagar has placed before the members of the committee regarding a G.R Case No. 91/10 where the Appellate Court has observed that the trial Court has delivered the judgement without examining the victim and therefore, has remanded back the case for examining the victim, but the victim has not been found in the mentioned address. In this regard the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sivasagar has asked the representative of the Police authority to submit a report regarding the whereabouts of the victim so that the case can be disposed off at the earliest date possible.

The Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sivasagar has also highlighted a few case nos. 25/16, 01/21 and 31/17 which are pending in the Court of Munsiff No.1 where the distress warrant has not been executed till date. In this regard, the Chief Judicial Magistrate has asked the representative of the Police authorities to direct the concerned I.O.'s to look into the matter at an early date possible.

The Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sivasagar has also asked the representative of the Police authority present in the meeting to direct the concerned I.O.s to ensure proper mentioning of the state of accused in the medical report furnished by Medical Officer.
